Please do let us know if you are experiencing difficulties in payments as soon as possible to avoid large balances accruing.

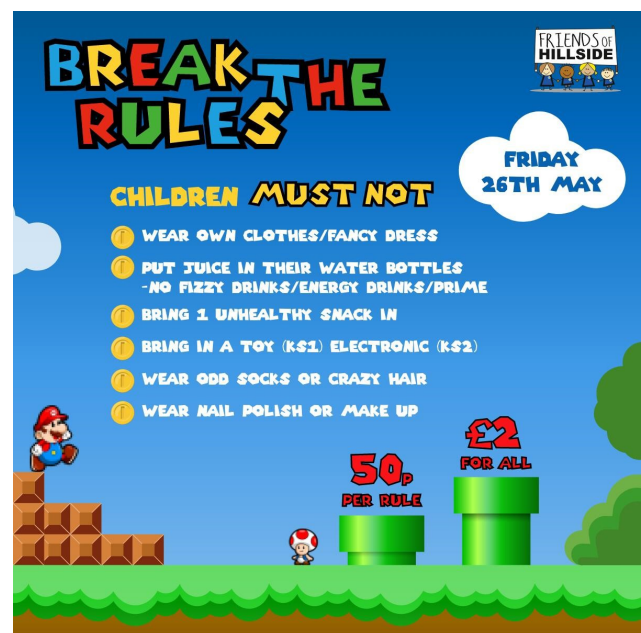


## Friends of Hillside:
