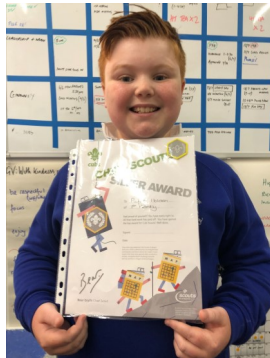

Green fingered Thomas and Evie

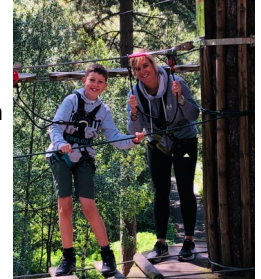
