We're delighted to be able to share with you details of our Summer Reading Challenge this year. Five thousand children from Cheshire West took part last year and we're hoping for more in 2024

The Challenge (4- to 12-year-olds) and Mini Challenge (Under 4s) are entirely free. Children are given a collector's pack for starting and stickers every time they read two books. After reading six books, they are given a certificate and a medal. Any books qualify, from the library or not, and can be in print, digital, or audio form.
