## Children's Snack

Can parents please note that children are allowed to bring in a healthy snack for morning break, and we suggest to parents that fruit is the most suitable option. So please can we reiterate that you have no nut products or products that may contain traces of nuts in the lunch boxes or as part of their snack.
